PARKING AROUND SCHOOL

We have again had concerns from local residents, our parents and from Barbara Priestman Academy regarding inconsiderate parking around our schools.

Parents inform us that they are having to walk on the road with pushchairs due to being unable to use the footpath because of cars parked on the pavements, residents are reporting cars parking over their drives, double parking on both sides of the road and in certain instances reports of abuse!

Any concerns or reports around public & pupil safety are taken very seriously and we would advise you to continue to report any concerns and/or abuse to the

We will continue to work closely with the community police, the local council and community in trying to improve the traffic situation and parking around St. Mary's and in addition to the school crossing patrols on Durham Road and Queen Alexandra Road, you may note that there will be a greater presence by police and parking camera around the school at peak times due to safety concerns.
