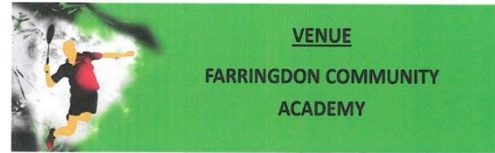
HEADLICE
