



PLAYTIME CHARTER

Article 15 – You have the right to meet other children as long as this does not stop other children from enjoying their rights

Article 19 – You have the right to be protected and be safe

Article 31 – You have the right to play and relax.



Children - We will do this by:

- being friendly and showing respect to other children
- telling a friend or adult if they are upset or feel unsafe
- using kind words
- looking after our and others' property
- treating others as we wish to be treated
- Speak up and tell an adult if we see bullying behaviour (there is no such thing as an innocent bystander)



Adults (Duty Bearers) - We will do this by:

- Ensuring that we are on time and positioned where we can have the most positive influence on play, and children feel happy and safe
- Helping children to play respectfully with friends
- Helping children to feel included. Treat all children with respect
- Listen to and help anyone who feels they are being badly treated or bullied
