
# Key Dates in Year 1- Autumn Term.

# Phonics Screening Test

## June - Phonics Screening Test

40 words - usually 20 real words and 20 nonsense words

Short assessment to confirm whether children have learnt how to decode words using phonics.

You can access past papers online if wanting to practice with your child at home.



## How can you help?

- **Reading:** Little and often. Reading book & free choice book.
- **Log in to Oxford Owl for the reading book your child is reading in school.**
- **Phonics:** children will be given the Speed Sound Book to practise sounds from January onwards. They will be given specific sounds in the Autumn Term.
- **Spelling:** children will be given spellings to practise at home and school - (Spring Term)
- **Maths:** Recognise numbers to 100. Number bonds to 10.
