













Read Write Inc Reading/Writing Scheme

- Login to Oxford Owl
- Every Friday your child will have a new book issued online which is the book we have read in school that week.
- Your child will be fluent when reading this book.

Please return the reading books on time.


- Please listen to your child read aloud as often as you can little and often is always best.





Other Curriculum Information

- PE is on Wednesday for both classes. This will be taught by our specialist PE coach
- Every Wednesday both classes will also have a music lesson with Mrs. Paget.
- Yr1 reading folders can be brought in every week to swap for a new free choice book.

How can you help?

- Reading: Little and often. Reading book & free choice book.
- Log in to Oxford Owl for the reading book your child is reading in school.
- Phonics: children will be given the Speed Sound Book to practise sounds from January onwards. They will be given specific sounds in the Autumn Term.
- Spelling: children will be given spellings to practise at home and school (Spring Term)
- Maths: Recognise numbers to 100. Number bonds to 10.
- Log in to Numbots
- Access free online White Rose Maths Website One Minute Maths
