**Please remind children of the importance of a regular intake of water. Water is available in school and all children should have a plastic bottle clearly marked with their name and class.**

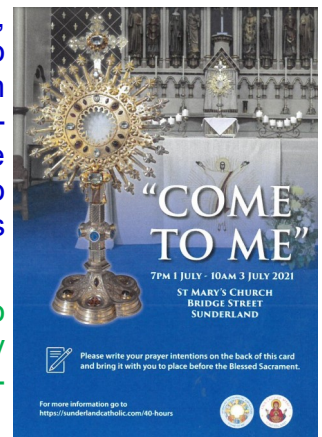
## 40 HOURS ADORATION
