

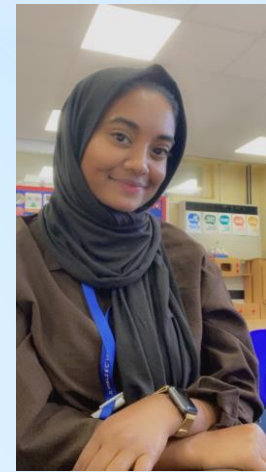

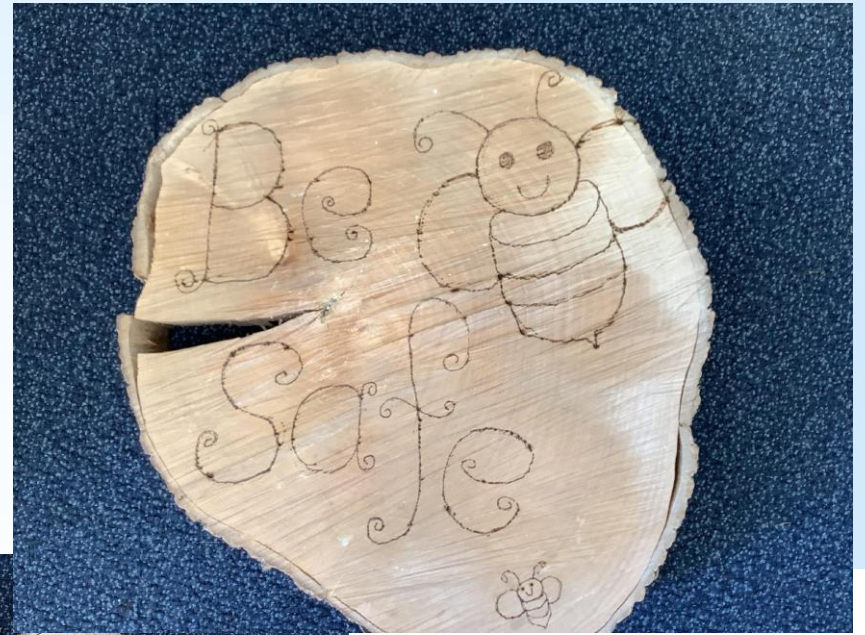
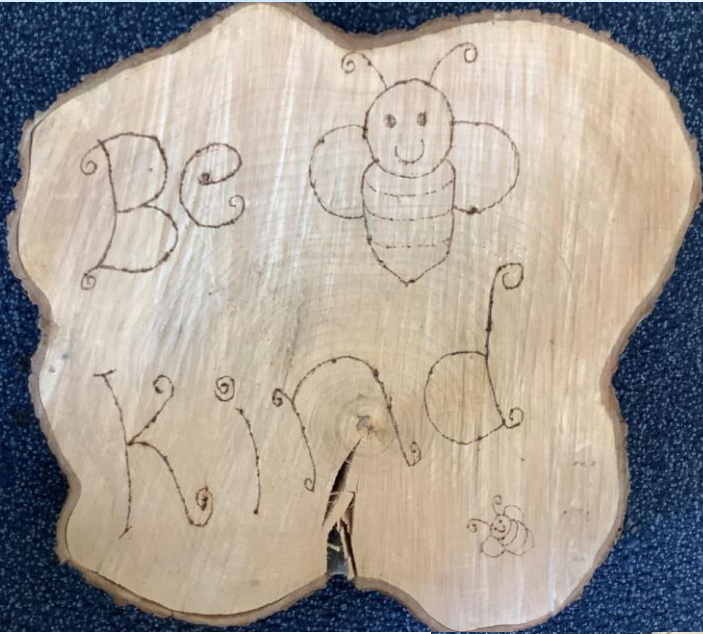
Year 1 - General information/ Key Dates
