


St. Mary's Prayers

The Confiteor

I confess to almighty God and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I have failed to do, through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; (beat chest 3X with right fist) therefore I ask blessed Mary ever-virgin, all the Angels and Saints, and you, my brothers and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord our God.

Stations of the Cross

1. Jesus is condemned to death
2. Jesus carries his cross
3. Jesus falls the first time
4. Jesus meets his mother
5. Simon of Cyrene helps Jesus carry the cross
6. Veronica wipes the face of Jesus
7. Jesus falls the second time
8. Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem
9. Jesus falls the third time
10. Jesus is stripped of his garments
11. Crucifixion: Jesus is nailed to the cross
12. Jesus dies on the cross
13. Jesus is taken down from the cross
14. Jesus is laid in the tomb.

Magnificat

The Apostles Creed

I believe in God the Father Almighty,
Creator of Heaven and earth; I believe
in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our
Lord,

He was conceived by the Holy Spirit
and born of the Virgin Mary. He
suffered under Pontius Pilate, was
crucified, died, and was buried. He
descended to the dead. On the third
day He rose again. He ascended into
Heaven and is seated at the right hand
of the Father. He will come again to
judge the living and the dead. I believe
in the Holy Spirit, the Holy Catholic
Church, the communion of Saints, the
forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of
the body, and the life everlasting.
