Gospel: Luke 18: 1 10—14

Jesus told this story. 'Two men went into church to pray. One of them was an important person called a Pharisee and he went straight to the front of church. The other one stayed at the back. The Pharisee prayed to God. "Look at me, God. I am so good and I do so many good things. Thank you for making me like this and not like that poor man at the back." The man who stayed at the back of church did not show off. He looked at the floor. "Please forgive me for doing the wrong thing. I am sorry". Jesus looked at the people. 'God listened to the man who stayed at the back because he did not boast and show off. God gave him peace.'

Help us to admit our mistakes.

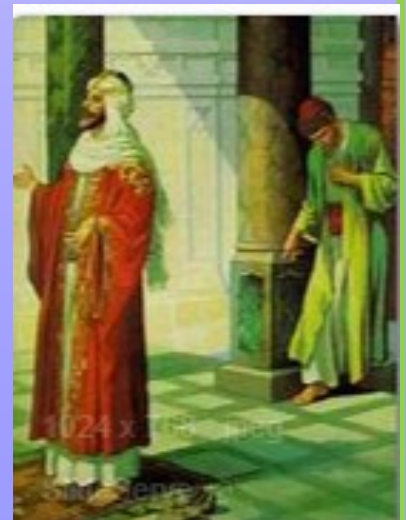
God will always love us, even if we make mistakes.
